

# BOAT RULES



1. You must be at least 14 years of age to check out boating equipment. Anyone under the age of 14 must be accompanied in the watercraft by an adult (at least 18 years old).
2. You must present a current assessment card or guest/non-member pass **and** a picture ID to check out watercraft.

3. Watercraft are checked out per hour, not per day or weekly. Watercraft and all equipment must be checked in before beachhouse closing, by 5:30 p.m. Last rental is 4:30 p.m.
4. A rowboat or canoe may be checked out after 4:30 p.m. for overnight use but must be returned between 11:00 a.m. and 12 noon the following morning.
5. **Failure to return craft and equipment on time and/or lock up to dock after each use will result in loss of your deposit and could result in loss of watercraft privileges.**
6. The beach attendant will record the local address of those who check out watercraft and will keep a log of late returns.
7. L/N watercraft are for use in L/N lakes only.
8. Under no circumstances are more than 3 people allowed in boats/canoes at one time, and only 2 or 4 people allowed in a paddleboat (one person per seat available).

9. You must have life preservers for everyone in the watercraft; after dark, you must have a flashlight.
10. Diving or swimming from watercraft is not allowed. You may not switch from one watercraft to another while out on the lake.
11. All watercraft must be kept away from the designated swimming areas.
12. If the attendant uses a bullhorn or gives verbal directions, you must respond or your privileges may be taken away.
13. Watercraft keys shall not be duplicated for any reason.
14. Special rules may apply for the three holiday weekends: Memorial, 4<sup>th</sup> of July and Labor Day.

***WHEN YOU SIGN FOR A WATERCRAFT, IT SIGNIFIES THAT YOU HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THESE RULES.***

FAILURE TO FOLLOW ANY OF THE 14 LISTED BOATING RULES MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF PRIVILEGES.

**Please check out boating equipment at designated beachhouses.** If beachhouse at desired location is closed please see the attendant at the Clubhouse or call for availability at 231-585-6320. (For overnight use, please check out equipment from a facility that will be open for business the following day for ease in retrieving your deposit.)
